## Awards

\$1,000, plus paid airfare and hotel expenses to attend the **Sixth Annual NACCE Conference, "Understanding the Value: Entrepreneurship Education, Economic Development, Fundraising"** in **Anaheim, CA from January 4-7, 2009** will be awarded to the winner of the faculty of the year award. \$1,000 will also be awarded to the winner's community college to support entrepreneurship. ## Nomination Rules and Regulations

All nominations must comply with the following criteria:

- Nominations are for any faculty person teaching entrepreneurship at a community college.
- Full and part-time faculty are eligible to be nominated.
- Nominations may come from students, faculty persons, or administrators.
- Nomination essays must be typed using 12-point type and include the following: Explain in detail why this faculty member deserves this award and how they support entrepreneurship education at their community college. If possible, please include one or two examples that demonstrate their excellence and dedication to teaching entrepreneurship.
- The nomination text is limited to a maximum of 500 words and a minimum of 400.
- Essay must have the following at the top of the first page submitted:
  - Person nominating with contact information including email
  - Faculty nominated with contact information including email
- Entries must be emailed to [vansickle@nacce.com](mailto:vansickle@nacce.com) by October 31, 2008.
- Essays will become the property of the National Association for Community College Entrepreneurship. The essays may be printed in educational publications and used in the future to promote the NACCE mission.

## Judging

Judging will take place in early November and the winner will be notified by email by November 18, 2008.
